3. The temporary 1.50% fuel surcharge in all rates and charges is the result of increased fuel costs incurred by the company during the months of September 2011 and October 2011, to be collected from customers as follows:

For customers who are billed monthly for services in arrears, the fuel surcharge applies to all services provided in the months of December 2011 and January 2012.
