Dear Mr. Wilder:

As you are aware, on March 9, 2012, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission sent a Penalty Assessment against Triangle Charter Service, LLC in the amount of \$200 for violation of WAC 480-30-071, which requires charter and excursion carriers to file annual safety reports and WAC 480-30-076, which requires such companies to pay regulatory fees annually with the Commission by December 31 each year. These violations result from Triangle Charter Service, LLC's failure to file its annual report for 2011 and pay the 2012 regulatory fee. The commission sent Triangle Charter Service, LLC a Notice of Intent to Cancel Certification as a Charter and Excursion Carrier and Opportunity to Request a Hearing, on April 4, 2012, a Second Notice on June 6, 2012, and a Final Notice on July 11, 2012.

The commission has not received the \$200 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$200 balance.
