1. The Commission finds good cause to support the request and authorize the proposed changes to become effective with Less Than Statutory Notice on: December 1, 2012.
2. The proposed changes will expire on: February 28, 2013.
3. The temporary 1.71% fuel surcharge in all rates and charges is the result of increased fuel costs incurred by the company during the months of September 2012 and October 2012, to be collected from customers as follows:

For customers who are billed monthly for services in arrears, the fuel surcharge applies to all services provided in the months of December 2012 and January 2013.

Customers who are billed bi-monthly for services – Current month and one month in advance:

January 2013	January 2013 and February 2013
