Dear Sir or Madam

As you are aware, on May 23, 2014, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Bayview Limousine Service, Inc. in the amount of \$1,000 for violation of WAC 480-30-071, which requires charter and excursion carriers to file annual reports with the Commission by May 1 each year. Bayview Limousine Service, Inc. has failed to file its annual report for 2013 and has incurred a penalty of \$1,000. The Commission sent Bayview Limousine Service, Inc. a Final Notice on July 1, 2014.

The Commission has not received the \$1,000 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$1,000 balance.
