Dear Mr. King:

Puget Sound Energy, Inc. (“PSE”) hereby submits in connection with Docket No. UE-143245 a replacement cover letter, the effect of which is to eliminate the Less Than Statutory Notice request and the associated request for a waiver of Customer Notice Rules (“LSN Notice Waiver”). The LSN Notice Waiver, per WAC 480-80-122, was submitted along with the initial filing of Docket No. UE-143245 on September 2, 2014.

The purpose of the Docket No. UE-143245 filing is to submit tariff sheets under Schedule 152 to replace the tariff sheets simultaneously being withdrawn in Docket No. UE-132140, in addition to the related updates to tariff provisions in Schedules 150, and 151 for electric interconnection service. The LSN Notice Waiver is no longer necessary after discussion with the Commission Staff and the substitute filing being made in Docket No. UE-132140.

Concurrently with this request of withdrawing the LSN Notice Waiver, PSE is submitting a separate substitute tariff filing of Docket No. UE-132140 to change the effective date of the interconnection service provisions in Schedule 80 so that these existing provisions are to be cancelled on October 3, 2014, in sync with the effective date of October 3, 2014, of the proposed tariff sheets submitted under Docket No. UE-143245 on September 2, 2014.
