- On December 19, 2014, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued Penalty Assessment UW-144112 against Newaukum Water System, Inc. (Newaukum or Company) in the amount of \$1,000, alleging a violation of RCW 80.28.080 which prohibits Companies from charging customers a rate that is higher than the rate published in its tariff.
- On January 5, 2015, Newaukum filed with the Commission a request for hearing stating, among other things, that the Company is financially stressed and that the increased rates are needed to continue the operation of the water system.
- Pursuant to RCW 34.05.482 and WAC 480-07-610, the Commission determines that a brief adjudicative proceeding is appropriate for determining whether the alleged violation of RCW 80.28.080 occurred and, if so, whether the penalty should be mitigated.
- THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That it will hold a brief adjudicative proceeding in this matter at 9:30 a.m., on Wednesday, February 11, 2015, in Room 206, Second Floor, Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington.
- The record in this case will consist of any documents regarding the matter that are considered by or prepared for the presiding officer for the brief adjudicative proceeding and a transcript of any oral statements given at the hearing, which statements will be given under oath.

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Written notice of any other stage in the proceeding or other formal proceedings that the Commission may deem appropriate will be given during the course of this case. The Commission will provide at its offices in Olympia, Washington, copies of documents in the current record for use by the parties or others who may want to review them.

- Parties wishing to submit any other documents for consideration at the brief adjudicative proceeding must file with the Commission a list enumerating and describing any such documents **no later than 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 4, 2015**, and bring an original and three (3) copies to the hearing. Filing shall be in accordance with WAC 480-07-140 and 145.
