Subject: **TR-160138 – Puget Sound & Pacific Railroad** Completion of Grade Crossing Protective Fund (GCPF) Project Sargent Blvd – USDOT 096687L

On February 4, 2016, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) awarded a GCPF grant totaling \$20,000 to Puget Sound and Pacific Railroad (PSAP) for a project involving modification of active warning devices at the Sargent Boulevard crossing in Aberdeen, identified as USDOT 096687L. The project was split into two grants: one in this docket and one in TR-160137. The estimated total project cost for this portion of the project was \$20,022.04. The actual cost of the project was \$20,562.50. PSAP paid the amount over the grant amount.

On December 16, 2016, PSAP submitted a request for reimbursement. Rail Safety staff had inspected the crossing on September 28, 2016, and confirmed that the project was completed according to the specifications outlined in the order approving the grant.
