Completion of Grade Crossing Protective Fund (GCPF) Project
SR-170 – 396429K

On May 8, 2017, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) awarded a GCPF grant totaling \$6,685 to the Columbia Basin Railroad (CBRR) for a project involving installation of LED lights and replacement of batteries at the SR-170 crossing in Grant County, identified as USDOT 396429K. The actual cost of the project was \$5,755.58.

On June 20, 2017, CBRR submitted a request for reimbursement. Rail Safety staff inspected the crossing on June 26, 2017, and confirmed that the project was completed according to the specifications outlined in the order approving the grant.
