On June 30, 2017 I submitted a petition contesting the penalty using the WA UTC efiling system. Looking back at my documentation, I see that I did not include the UT-170443 docket Number. This may have caused a disjoint in matching up the records. When e-filing the petition, I also had issues with uploading documents, due to the file naming. I received support assistance, per Support ID 2296754042376978672 from technician S. Kearse. Perhaps there was an issue and my filing was not successful. My initial e-filing attempts were on June 29, 2017.

With my petition, I provided documentation to show that Consolidated Communications Enterprise Services, Inc. (CCES) did not have the authority to do business in WA until January 22, 2017. Therefore, a 2016 report would not be applicable. Effective January 1, 2017 Enventis Telecom, Inc., merged with CCES and CCES was the surviving entity. Enventis Telecom, Inc. filed a YE 2016. The YE 2017 report will be filed by CCES.

Please let me know how to proceed with this matter, because I truly believe that the penalty is not applicable for Consolidated Communications Enterprise Services, Inc.
