Effective March 1, 2019, the Utilities and Transportation Commission grants Consolidated Communications of Washington Company, LLC, (dba Consolidated Communications) registration in Docket UT-190077 as an incumbent local exchange carriers (“ILEC”) telecommunications company for the Ellensburg, Selah, and Yelm exchanges, in the state of Washington. Enclosed is a certificate providing evidence that Consolidated Communications is authorized to provide telecommunication services in the state of Washington. As a registered telecommunications company, Consolidated Communications of Washington Company, LLC, must comply with the statutes and rules governing telecommunications companies including RCW Title 80, WAC 480-80, WAC 480-120, WAC 480-121, and WAC 480-123. As an “ILEC” the company is also designated as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier, or ETC, for those areas previously served by Ellensburg Telephone Company and YCOM Networks, Inc.

In accordance with WAC 480-120-385, Consolidated Communications of Washington Company, LLC, a) must submit to the commission **an annual report form and pay regulatory fees no later than May 1 of each year;** and b) must file financial information (as a Class B ILEC company) no later than July 1 of each year.

**NOTICE TO PARTIES:** This is an order delegated to the Secretary for decision. In addition to serving you a copy of the decision, the Commission will post on its Internet Web site for at least 14 days a listing of all matters delegated to the Secretary for decision. You may seek Commission review of this decision. You must file a request for Commission review of this order no later than fourteen (14) days after the date the decision is posted on the Commission's Web site. The Commission will schedule your request for review for consideration at a regularly scheduled open meeting. The Commission will notify you of the time and place of the open meeting at which the Commission will review the order.

The Commission will grant a late-filed request for review only on a showing of good cause, including a satisfactory explanation of why the person did not timely file the request. A form for late-filed requests is available on the Commission's Web site.

This notice and review process is pursuant to the provisions of RCW 80.01.030 and WAC 480-07-904(1)(k).
