Harrison Water Company/Kiona, LLC has filed a revision to its tariff with the Utilities and Transportation Commission (commission) to increase the following rates. If accepted, the changes will take place on April 1, 2019.

	Current Rates	Proposed Rates	Estimated Increased Revenue
Non-sufficient funds check fee	\$4.00	\$15.00	\$88 (8 NSF checks)
Service Visit/Charge	\$25.00	\$50.00	\$150 (for 6 visits)
Account Set-up Charge	\$15.00	\$25.00	\$50 (for 5 customers)

The above fees are being increased to better align with the costs of doing business. The non-sufficient funds check fee is being increased to match the fee charged by our bank for non-sufficient checks. The Service Visit Charge applies when a utility employee or agent is dispatched to a customer's premise for a condition caused by the customer.

Any future changes to the tariff will be reviewed by the commission and a notice of changes will be provided to our customers. The commission protects consumers by ensuring utility and transportation services are fairly priced, available, reliable, and safe. Regulated companies must obtain the commission's approval before they can change rates or services to their customers.
