RE: Commission Staff's Letter Confirming Compliance DG-190249 – Rodarte Construction, Inc. – Investigation #7953

Dear Mr. Johnson:

Commission staff (staff) has reviewed the compliance order for Rodarte Construction, Inc. (Rodarte Construction or Company) dated May 16, 2019. Compliance with the order required the following items be met:

• \$2,000 penalty for one violation of RCW 19.122.030(6), with the opportunity to suspend, and ultimately waive, the entire \$2,000 penalty amount if the company incurs no additional dig law violations within 12 months of the penalty assessment.

On May 31, 2019, the Company notified the Commission of its acceptance of the conditions. The Company has not incurred any additional violations of the dig law since the penalty assessment.

Staff believes that Rodarte Construction has fully complied with the Commission's order, and further compliance under this order is no longer necessary. Therefore, staff recommends the Commission waive the suspended \$2,000 penalty amount and close this docket.
