Dear Mr. Johnson:

On September 6, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) assessed a \$6,100 penalty in Docket TV-190694 against Iron Man Movers and Storage, Inc. (Iron Man Movers or Company) for violations of WAC 480-15-570, Driver Safety Requirements, which adopts Title 49 CFR Part 391 – Qualifications of Drivers.

On September 16, 2019, Iron Man Movers contacted Commission staff (Staff) to request a payment plan for the \$6,100 penalty. On September 17, 2019, Staff and the Company came to a mutual agreement on a proposed payment plan, as follows:
