Re: Charter/Party Bus Services

Dear Mr. Konopik:

The purpose of this letter is to provide technical assistance to you with respect to Washington's passenger transportation licensing requirements.

The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) believes that you are engaged in passenger transportation services that require a certificate of authority from the Commission. Bus tour services advertised online by Kraken Tours WA are charter services under WAC 480-30-036 and are regulated by the Commission. Offering these services without a charter certificate is illegal, is considered a gross misdemeanor, and is punishable as such (see RCW 81.70.220 and WAC 480-30-246).

To avoid enforcement action by the Commission, no later than February 7, 2019, please either submit a complete application for charter authority, with proof of insurance, or explain in writing why you believe your business does not require charter authority from the Commission. Please explain the nature of your company's operations in detail. Direct your written response to Ms. Kathryn McPherson at PO Box 47250, Olympia, WA 98504-7250 or by email at <a href="mailto:kathryn.mcpherson@utc.wa.gov">kathryn.mcpherson@utc.wa.gov</a>.






