Effective November 18, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) grants the application of King County Housing Authority in Docket US-190899 for registration as a community solar company. This letter is evidence that King County Housing Authority is a registered community solar company in the state of Washington. As a registered community solar company, King County Housing Authority must comply with the statutes and rules governing community solar companies, including but not limited to the rules in WAC 480-103-001 though WAC 480-103-999.

In accordance with WAC 480-103-020(4) and WAC 480-103-030, King County Housing Authority, must submit to the Commission a complete annual report form, along with an application to renew the company's registration if it continues to seek to operate as a community solar company, and pay the renewal application fee and regulatory fees no later than May 1 of each year.
