**NOTICE CANCELLING BRIEF ADJUDICATIVE PROCEEDING**

RE: *In the Matter of Determining the Proper Carrier Classification of, and Complaint for Penalties Against, Starving Students, Inc.,*

TO ALL PARTIES:

On June 15, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) caused to be served on CT Corporation System (CT Corporation), the registered agent of Starving Students, Inc. (Starving Students or Company), Order 01, Order Instituting Special Proceeding; Complaint Seeking to Impose Penalties; Notice of Brief Adjudicative Proceeding (Order 01), as well as the Declaration of Brian Braun (Declaration). On June 16, 2020, the Commission filed those documents in Docket TV-200309 and scheduled a brief adjudicative proceeding for July 27, 2020, at 9:30 a.m.

On June 24, 2020, CT Corporation submitted a letter to the Commission stating that because the Company ceased operating in Washington in 2013, CT Corporation was no longer its registered agent and therefore was unable to accept service on the Company's behalf.

Due to insufficient service of process, the Commission finds good cause to cancel the brief adjudicative proceeding and reschedule it for a later date, allowing the Commission to serve the Company with sufficient time for it to answer and appear at the brief adjudicative proceeding.<sup>1</sup>

**THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the brief adjudicative proceeding set for July 27, 2020, at 9:30 a.m. is canceled.**
