 DG-200452– Premier Paving and Sealcoat, LLC - Investigation # 8181

Dear Ms. Maxwell:

Commission staff (staff) has reviewed the Notice of Penalty order for Premier Paving and Sealcoat LLC (Premier Paving or Company) dated August 20, 2020. Compliance with the order required the following items be met:

- \$3,500 penalty for two violations of RCW 19.122, with the opportunity to suspend, and ultimately waive, \$3,000 of the penalty amount if the Company management and field crew responsible for excavation complete Dig Safe Training through the National Utility Contractors Association (NUCA) within 12 months of the penalty assessment and incur no additional dig law violations for 12 months.

On September 16, 2020, Premier Paving notified the Commission of its acceptance of the conditions and made a payment of \$500. On October 20, 2021, Premier Paving submitted a certificate of completion for NUCA Dig Safe training. The Company has not incurred any additional violations of the dig law since the penalty assessment.

Staff believes Premier Paving has fully complied with the Commission’s order, and further compliance under this order is no longer necessary. Staff recommends the Commission waive the suspended \$3,000 penalty amount and close the docket.
