RE: Commission Staff's Letter Confirming Compliance DG –210259 Greenbuild Development - Investigation # 8345

Dear Ms. Maxwell

Commission staff (staff) has reviewed the compliance order for Greenbuild Development (Greenbuild or Company) dated May 5, 2021. Compliance with the order required the following items to be met:

• \$1,000 penalty for one violation of RCW 19.122, with the opportunity to suspend the penalty, and ultimately waive the \$1,000 penalty amount on the conditions: (1) the Company supervisors and applicable field staff attend NUCA Dig Safe online Training and (2) the Company incurs no other dig law violations within 12 months.

On June 7, 2021, Greenbuild signed the acceptance of conditions. On June 4, 2021, Greenbuild submitted verification of training completion. Greenbuild has not incurred any additional violations of the dig law since the penalty assessment.

Staff believes Greenbuild has fully complied with the Commission's order, and further compliance under this order is no longer necessary. Staff recommends the Commission waive the suspended \$1,000 penalty amount and close the docket.
