On June 28, 2022, Avista Corporation, dba Avista Utilities (Avista or the Company), filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) its “Petition For an Order Authorizing Temporary Exemption of WAC 480-90-343, WAC 480-90-348 and Associated Company Tariffs” (Petition), in accordance with WAC 480-90-008 and WACs 480-07-110 and 370(3). On September 12, 2022, the Company filed a revised Petition along with a Less than Statutory Notice request for a revised tariff page that effectively removed the language from which Avista is seeking exemption in WN U-29, Schedule 170. After additional discussion with Commission Staff, it was requested that Avista update the tariff page filed to reflect an effective date of September 30, 2022. Tariff Schedule 170-U is enclosed with this filing, reflecting the updated effective date.
