The company requests Commission approval to amend its filed Tariff Number 5 on Less than Statutory Notice to include a Special Fuel Surcharge Tariff Supplement to recover the rising cost of fuel. Fuel index prices have increased from \$2.682 per gallon for the base period to \$5.298 per gallon current price. Proposed changes are to add a Special Fuel Surcharge Supplement No.3 in the amount of 2.81%.

3. The temporary 2.81% fuel surcharge in all rates and charges is the result of increased fuel costs incurred by the company during the months of September and October 2022, to be collected from customers as follows:
