\* Company proposes to change (Include Title of Provision, Tariff number and Sheets/Pages being changed): Rates affected by disposal price increase from King County solid waste. Tariff 11, pages 21-24, 27, 30, 33, 39-42.

\* Present provisions are: King County combined disposal rate is \$183.71/ton.

\* Proposed changes are: Disposal rate \$165.91/ton plus fixed cost \$34.51/ton = \$200.42/ton effective Jan 1, 2025.

\* Explain why the company is proposing this tariff revision: King County disposal change in rates effective Jan 1, 2025.
