Scheduled 582, Unprotected Excess Deferred Income Tax (EDIT) Reversals Rate Adjust.

Director Killip,

On September 15, 2025, Cascade Natural Gas Corporation ("Cascade" or "Company") submitted Advice No. W25-08-04, docketed as UG-250707. Cascade now submits the following as a replacement cover letter to that filing. This replacement cover letter includes bill impacts for Schedule 900, Biomethane Receipt Services customers. The tariff sheet, work paper, and requested effective date remain unchanged as filed on September 15, 2025.

The purpose of Cascade's UG-250707 filing is to adjust the Unprotected EDIT (Excess Deferred Income Tax) reversals rate adjustment in accordance with the true-up provision adopted in Order No. 06 in Docket UG-170929.

Schedule 582, Unprotected EDIT reflects an annual revenue decrease of \$176,050 to customers or a decrease in annual revenue of 0.04 percent. The impact to an average residential customer using 53 therms per month will be a \$0.03 decrease or 0.03 percent.

The proposed change will affect all of Cascade's retail sales customers. Cascade serves approximately 205,693 residential, 27,641 commercial and 492 industrial customers in the state of Washington.

In compliance with WAC 480-90-194(3), the Company began mailing customers a bill insert notifying them of the proposed rate increase. The issuance of bill inserts to customers began on September 15 and ends October 15. In addition, Cascade published on its webpage the anticipated rate increase, provided copies of the notice to Community Action Agencies and organizations within its service territory, and provided notice to the news media. The Company filed a copy of the bill insert in a separate filing, Advice No. W25-09-01, docketed as UG-250708.
