# ORDER OF CONSOLIDATION AND NOTICE OF HEARING (December 8, 1995)

Docket No. TR-940287 is in the nature of a complaint against Burlington Northern Railroad Company (Burlington) and was filed on December 29, 1993, and amendment was filed February 10, 1994. A copy of the complaint and amendment was served by the Commission upon respondent and Answer and Motion to Dismiss for Lack of Jurisdiction was filed on March 21, 1994. The complaint indicates a dispute exists between complainant and respondents regarding liability and cost of maintaining a crossing over Burlington Northern Railroad Company tracks at Milepost 1512.27, approximately one mile west of Edwall, Washington. A more detailed account of the dispute is reflected in the foregoing complaint which is available for inspection at the Commission's office.

By letter, in Docket No. TR-940851, dated June 23, 1994, Lincoln County filed a petition with the Commission for an order directing the construction of a grade crossing over Burlington tracks at Burlington MP 1507.87 located in:

NW¼ of the NW¼, Section 3, Township 23 North, Range 39 E.W.M., North of County Road 63620, Lincoln County, Washington.

The petition states that the following are the maximum speeds for trains within this area:

Passenger 70 MPH Freight 60 MPH

("MP" stands for milepost)

By letter, in Docket No. TR-940852, dated June 23, 1994, Lincoln County filed a petition with the Commission for an order directing the construction of a grade crossing over Burlington tracks at Burlington MP 1512.27 located in:

SW¼ of the SW¼, Section 12, Township 23 North, Range 38 E.W.M. North of County Road No. 96100, Lincoln County, Washington.

The petition states that the following are the maximum speeds for trains within this area:

Passenger 70 MPH Freight 60 MPH

Inasmuch as the foregoing matters involve common questions of fact and law, it has been determined that they should be consolidated for hearing and determination.

#### ORDER OF CONSOLIDATION

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED That each of the above-entitled dockets be and the same is consolidated for hearing and determination, with the Commission reserving the right to hold such separate hearings and to issue separate orders in individual dockets as it may deem appropriate.

#### **NOTICE OF HEARING**

Hearing in this matter is being held pursuant to Part IV of chapter 34.05 RCW pertaining to adjudicative proceedings, including but not limited to RCW 34.05.413, 34.05.440, 34.05.449, 34.05.452, and 80.01.040. In Docket No. TR-940287,

statutes cited by the respective parties included chapter 62A RCW, RCW 81.01.010, 81.04.020, .110, .380, .385, .405, .440, .460, .510, 81.52.050, 81.52.060, chapter 81.53 RCW, RCW 81.53.010, 81.53.030, and 81.04.040. The commission has jurisdiction over these matters under Title 81 RCW, and has legal authority to determine whether to establish public grade crossings pursuant to 81.53 RCW, including without limitation, RCW 81.53.030 and 81.53.060. In addition to the foregoing statutes, rules involved include those within chapter 480-09 WAC relating to practice and procedure. The issues involved in Docket TR-940287 are stated above and more specifically in the pleadings herein. The ultimate issues involved in Dockets No. TR-940851 and No. TR-940852 are whether public crossings should be established.

NOTICE IS GIVEN THAT ANY PARTY WHO FAILS TO ATTEND OR PARTICIPATE IN THE HEARING SET HEREIN, OR OTHER STAGE OF THIS PROCEEDING, MAY BE HELD IN DEFAULT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TERMS OF RCW 34.05.440.
