RE: Commission Staff's Letter Confirming Compliance DG-210547, TTAP Construction Services LLC - Investigation # 8376

Dear Ms. Maxwell,

Commission staff (staff) has reviewed the compliance order for TTAP Construction Services, LLC (TTAP or Company) dated September 13, 2021. Compliance with the order required the following:

- The Company is to pay a \$200 portion of a \$1,000 penalty amount, suspend and ultimately waive the remaining \$800 portion of the penalty; and
- The Company supervisors and applicable field staff attend NUCA Dig Safe online training; and
- The Company incurs no other dig law violations within 12 months.

On September 21, 2021, TTAP notified the Commission of its acceptance of the conditions and made a \$200 payment. On September 30, 2021, the Company submitted verification of completion of the training, and the Company has not incurred any additional violations of the dig law since the penalty assessment.

Staff believes TTAP has fully complied with the Commission's order, and further compliance under this order is no longer necessary. Staff recommends the Commission waive the suspended \$800 penalty amount and close the docket.
