RE: Commission Staff's Letter Confirming Compliance DG-210687, R.P.C. LLC d/b/a Rock Placing Company - Investigation # 8387

Dear Ms. Maxwell

Commission staff (staff) has reviewed the compliance order for R.P.C. LLC d/b/a Rock Placing Company (RPC or Company) dated October 4, 2021. Compliance with the order required the following:

- The Company is to pay a \$200 portion of the \$1,000 penalty amount, suspend and ultimately waive the remaining \$800 portion of the penalty.
- The Company supervisors and applicable field staff attend NUCA Dig Safe online training and;
- The Company incurs no other dig law violations within 12 months.

On September 12, 2021, RPC notified the Commission of its acceptance of the conditions. On September 18, 2021, the Company submitted a \$200 payment. On September 9, 2022, the Company submitted verification of completion of Dig Safe training. The Company has not incurred any additional violations of the dig law since the penalty assessment.

Staff believes RPC has fully complied with the Commission's order, and further compliance under this order is no longer necessary. Staff recommends the Commission waive the suspended \$800 penalty amount and close the docket.
