Dear Mr. Freeland:

As you are aware, on May 26, 2022, the Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a penalty assessment against Greenland Industries LLC in the amount of \$1,000 for violations of the Commission's dig laws. The penalty was due 15 days after the company's receipt of that notice. On July 13, 2022, a Final Notice was sent to Greenland Industries LLC in the amount of \$1,000, which was due on receipt. To date, the Commission has not received the balance due.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You will likely incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest, which will be added to your \$1,000 balance.
