Rates affected by disposal price increase from King County solid waste. Tariff 11, pages 21-24, 27, 30, 33, 39-42.

* Present provisions are:
King County combined disposal rate is \$183.71/ton.

* Proposed changes are:
Disposal rate \$165.91/ton plus fixed cost \$34.51/ton = \$200.42/ton effective Jan 1, 2025.

* Explain why the company is proposing this tariff revision:
King County disposal change in rates effective Jan 1, 2025.

* Explain why the Commission should allow this tariff revision to take effect with less than 30 days' notice (45 days' notice for solid waste):

The company is requesting LSN to allow the customers to be noticed on the first bill mailed after the effective date of January 1, 2025, as stated in WAC 480-70-271 (2). The LSN date is the effective date of tariff revision - January 1, 2025.

Change in rate is a pass through from increases in King County's solid waste disposal rate.
