The company requests Commission approval to amend its filed Tariff Number 8 on Less than Statutory Notice to implement a Special Fuel Surcharge Tariff Supplement to recover the rising cost of fuel. Fuel index prices have increased from \$2.837 per gallon for the base period to \$6.0560 per gallon current price. The Supplement would be in effect through May 31, 2026. Proposed change is to implement a 1.58% in Special Fuel Surcharge Supplement No. 12. Special Fuel Surcharge Supplement No. 11 expired on January 31, 2024. The company request less than statutory notice allowing the customers to be noticed on the first bill as previously allowed per WAC 480-70-271(2)(a).
