It has come to DTG's attention that Snohomish County sent a letter to Staff dated February 14, 2025. In that letter, Snohomish County described how, "[w]ith respect to the transport of residual waste materials to the County's intermodal facility, in the County's view DTG is currently operating within the scope of [its Residual Reclamation Waste] program as it was designed."
