NOTICE REVISING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

NOTICE OF HEARING (Set for June 20, 2018, at 9 a.m.)

Re: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Cascade Natural Gas Corporation, Docket UG-170929

TO ALL PARTIES:

On August 31, 2017, Cascade Natural Gas Corporation (Cascade or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) revisions to its currently effective Tariff WN U-3 for natural gas service the Company provides in Washington. The Commission suspended the as-filed tariffs and set the matter for hearing in Order 01 on September 14, 2017.

On October 9, 2017, the Commission convened a prehearing conference in this docket and adopted an agreed procedural schedule. On October 10, 2017, the Commission entered Order 03; Prehearing Conference Order; Notice of Hearing, which established the procedural schedule, including an evidentiary hearing set for May 15-17, 2018.

On April 27, 2018, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter informing the Commission that the parties had reached a partial settlement in principle and requesting that the Commission suspend the procedural schedule to allow the parties to finalize and file their agreement and supporting documentation. That same day, counsel for Staff sent the presiding administrative law judge an email notifying the Commission that the parties had agreed to the following revised procedural schedule:
