

WUTC Data Request 61

In response to Staff Data Request 57, the Company responded with, “where the Commission approved several PacifiCorp rate proposals, that are similarly reflected in the CEIP Biennial Update.”

- (a) Does the Company believe that the Commission approval of rate proposals is an approval of the reduction of interim targets?
- (b) Does the Company believe that approval of rate proposals excuse it from not procuring renewable and non-emitting energy to meet the needs of the Company’s obligations for CETA?

Response to WUTC Data Request 61

- (a) PacifiCorp believes that positions taken by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (WUTC) and WUTC staff should be consistent across proceedings and that interim targets should be updated to include current information in accordance with prudent utility planning and operations.
- (b) PacifiCorp does not understand the premise of the question. PacifiCorp’s Clean Energy Implementation Plan (CEIP) Biennial Update continues to show compliance with Washington’s Clean Energy Transformation Act (CETA) by 2030. At issue in the proceeding are interim targets under the Company’s first CEIP.

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
