On August 7, 2002, Puget Sound Energy, Inc. ("PSE") requested an extension of time for filing portions of the notice required in the Thirteenth Supplemental Order issued in this proceeding on July 29, 2002, as to the testimony and exhibits on which PSE will rely at hearing on the remaining contested issues in this proceeding.
