Dear Ms. Washburn:

Public Counsel was not served with the initial Transmittal No. 3637T compliance filing in this matter, filed October 24 and now withdrawn. On November 21, Qwest notified the undersigned by phone of the earlier filing, of the failure to serve, and of the impending withdrawal of the transmittal for replacement by a new filing. On November 27, 2007, Qwest served Public Counsel with two sets of documents comprising its replacement filing. Qwest offered to meet with Public Counsel to walk through the documents. That meeting occurred today at 9:30 a.m. and was helpful to Public Counsel in describing the nature and contents of the filing. However, given the short amount of time for review since the documents were received, Public Counsel does not take a position as to whether the filing establishes compliance with the Commission's orders establishing the terms of the AFOR.
