**NOTICE MODIFYING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

RE: *Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power & Light Company*  
Docket UE-220376

On June 6, 2022, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission), through its staff (Staff), issued a Complaint and Notice of Prehearing Conference in Docket UE-220376 (Complaint). The Complaint alleges that PacifiCorp violated Commission Order 01 in Docket UE-210829,<sup>1</sup> Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 19.280.030(3)(a)(ii), RCW 19.280.030(3)(a)(iii), Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-100-640(7), and WAC 480-100-660(4) by failing to incorporate the social cost of greenhouse gases (SCGHG) in the preferred portfolio of its Clean Energy Implementation Plan (CEIP). The Complaint requested the Commission find PacifiCorp in violation of statute, Commission rule, and Commission order and assess a penalty of \$1,000 per day for each of the five violations alleged.

The Commission convened a virtual prehearing conference on June 30, 2022, before Administrative Law Judge Andrew J. O'Connell.

On July 5, 2022, the Commission issued Order 01, granting, among other things, a motion to continue the prehearing conference until a number of issues were resolved by Commission order.

On September 6, 2022, the Commission reconvened the prehearing conference. The parties presented an agreed procedural schedule, which the Commission adopted in Order 04 with

the requirement that the parties submit to the Commission by September 14, 2022, an agreed date for post-hearing briefs.

On September 14, 2022, the parties contacted Judge O'Connell and indicated their agreement to submit to the Commission post-hearing briefs in this matter by February 9, 2023. The Commission finds good cause to modify the current procedural schedule, updating it with the parties' agreed deadline for submitting post-hearing briefs.

**THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That it modifies the procedural schedule, Appendix A to this Notice, to include the parties' agreed deadline of February 9, 2023, for submitting post-hearing briefs in this matter.**
