RE: *Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Puget Sound Energy, Inc.*, Docket Nos. UG-040640, *et al.*

TO ALL PARTIES:

The Commission entered its Order No. 06 in these dockets on February 18, 2005. The Order, among other things, rejected a general rate proceeding tariff filed by Puget Sound Energy, Inc., on April 5, 2004, which was suspended by prior Commission order. Order No. 06 authorized and required the Company to file tariff sheets consistent with its terms. On February 25, 2005, Puget Sound Energy, Inc., filed electric and gas tariff sheets as specified in the Order.

On March 1, 2005, the Commission served its Order No. 07 in these dockets granting in part and denying in part two motions for clarification, and denying a petition for reconsideration. On March 3, 2005, Puget Sound Energy, Inc., filed replacement tariff sheets to comply with the Commission’s Orders. On March 3, 2005, the Commission approved the original or replacement tariff sheets, as appropriate, with an effective date of March 4, 2005.

On March 7, 2005, Puget Sound Energy, Inc., filed a replacement tariff sheet for Schedule 7 to comply with Commission Order No. 06. The revised tariff sheet is:

The purpose of PSE’s filing is to incorporate the proper block rate structure as reflected in Order No. 06. This filing does not change the rates in Schedule 7. The Commission has examined the Company’s filing. It appears to comply with the terms of the Commission’s Order. Therefore, the tariff sheet listed above will become effective as filed with an effective date of March 8, 2005.
