TracFone Wireless, Inc. ("TracFone") advises the Commission by this letter that it will not be filing a quarterly report for the quarter ending on June 30, 2010, as required by Order 03 issued on June 24, 2010 in the above-referenced docket. In the Order, the Commission adopted a settlement agreement between Commission Staff and TracFone and granted TracFone's petition for designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier in Washington. As part of the settlement agreement, TracFone is required to report, on a quarterly basis, the number of Lifeline customers by service plan that it enrolls each month and the number of deactivated Lifeline customers each month by service plan and the reasons for deactivation. The first quarterly report is due July 30, 2010. However, TracFone has not yet commenced offering Lifeline service in Washington. Therefore, at this time, it has no information to report.
