Dear Mr. Danner:

On October 1, 2010 Puget Sound Energy (the “Company”) filed with the Commission proposed changes to its natural gas tariffs affecting approximately 749,031 natural gas customers. The Company provided notice of that filing pursuant to WAC 480-90-194(2).

The Commission, on October 28, 2010, issued Order 01, Complaint and Order Suspending Tariff Revisions in order that the Commission could investigate the need for the requested increase. On November 24, 2010, the Commission issued Order 03, Prehearing Conference Order; Notice of Hearing (Set for March 14, 2011) (“Order 03”). Order 03 provided for a public comment hearing to be held in this docket on March 14, 2011, for which the Company began issuing notice in the form of a message printed on customer bills.

Following discussion with the Commission’s staff, Public Counsel, and other parties, the Company agreed to insert a notice of the hearings, as a separate insert, in customer bills.

Pursuant to WAC 480-90-198, Notice Verification and Assistance, the Company is providing this statement that it is causing to be inserted in customers bills a notice of the public comment hearing in the above-referenced filing in accordance with WAC 480-90-197, Adjudicative proceedings where public testimony will be taken. The Company also states that the notice was inserted in customer bills beginning on December 21, 2010 and will continue until January 20, 2011. A copy of the insert is enclosed. A press release summarizing the published notice has been issued to the news editors of at least one newspaper of general circulation, at least one television station and at least one radio station within the Company’s service area.
