STIPULATION REGARDING PRODUCTION OF CONFIDENTIAL WMW INFORMATION TO SPOKANE COUNTY'S EXPERT KEN GIMPEL

I. INTRODUCTION

- 7. The parties to this proceeding hereby enter into this Stipulation Regarding Production of WMW's Confidential Information to Spokane County's Expert Ken Gimpel in order to protect certain confidential information of Waste Management of Washington, Inc., d/b/a Waste Management of Spokane ("WMW").
- 2. Mr. Gimpel is currently the Assistant Utilities Division Director, Solid Waste/Fleet Services for the City of Spokane. Until October 2012, Mr. Gimpel was employed by WMW as the Municipal Relations Director for central and eastern Washington and Idaho.
- 3. On Friday, March 20, 2015, Spokane County disclosed that it has designated Mr. Gimpel as an expert in this proceeding.

STIPULATION REGARDING PRODUCTION OF CONFIDENTIAL WMW INFORMATION TO SPOKANE COUNTY'S EXPERT KEN GIMPEL - 1

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- WMW raised certain objections to Mr. Gimpel serving as an expert in this matter to Spokane County, including that he has a confidentiality agreement with WMW pursuant to his prior employment with WMW, that his current employer, the City of Spokane has a contract with WMW for processing city recyclable materials at WMW's Materials Recovery Facility ("MRF"), and that the City of Spokane competes with WMW for certain commercial recycling services.
- Work papers submitted by WMW as part of its general rate request ("Work Papers") include valuable commercial information, including confidential cost and financial information, related to its commercial recycling operations, and its Spokane MRF operations. Due to WMW's concerns, Spokane County has agreed that Mr. Gimpel will not be permitted to review underlying financial analysis contained in the Work Papers related to WMW's commercial recycling operations or its Spokane MRF operations
- 6. As such, the parties agree that Mr. Gimpel will be provided with a separate redacted copy of WMW's work papers which exempts from view all underlying financial analysis related to WMW's commercial recycling operations and the operation of its Spokane MRF.
- 7. In addition, because the Commission Staffs' work papers are based on the information provided in WMW's Work Papers, any information produced to Spokane County by the WUTC during the course of this proceeding will also exempt from Mr. Gimpel's review all financial analysis and information related to WMW's commercial recycling operations and the operation of its Spokane MRF.

II. STIPULATION

8. Pursuant to the stipulation of the parties and for the reasons stated above, the following materials will be redacted from the Work Papers that Ken Gimpel has permission to review:

- A. "CM Recycle" Operations Income Statement/Actuals and Budgets

 Comparison/Commercial RCY WTB: All information in this file relates to commercial recycling and is prohibited from review by Mr. Gimpel.
- B. "Com'l FL Rec." WM of Spokane Report for Commercial Frontload Recycling (Report Dates 1/1/2013-12/31/2013): All information in this file relates to commercial recycling and is prohibited from review by Mr. Gimpel.
- C. "Com'l Organics" WM of Spokane Report for Commercial Organics (Report Dates 1/1/2013-12/31/2013): All information in this file relates to commercial recycling and is prohibited from review by Mr. Gimpel.
- D. "MRF ROR Analysis" WM of Spokane Mrf ROR Analysis: All information in this file relates to the SMaRT MRF and is prohibited from review by Mr. Gimpel.
- E. "Roll Off Disposal (includes recycling disposal)" WM of Spokane Report for Rolloff (Report Dates 1/1/2013-12/31/2013): Redacted information in this file relates to commercial recyclable materials and is prohibited from review by Mr. Gimpel.
- F. "Rolloff (includes roll off recycling)" Operations Income Statement/Actuals and Budgets/Roll Off WTB: Redacted information in this file that relates to collection of commercial recyclable materials by roll off is prohibited from review by Mr. Gimpel.
- G. "SMaRT Fixed Assets" Net Book Value Detail/Business Unit 02968 Spokane Material & Recycling T/Book FINANCIAL/As of Year 2013, Period 12: All information in this file relates to the SMaRT MRF and is prohibited from review by Mr. Gimpel.
- H. "SMaRT Inc. Statement" Operations Income Statement/Actuals and Prior Year Comparison/SMART Center MRF-02968: All information in this file relates to the SMaRT MRF and is prohibited from review by Mr. Gimpel.
