Enclosed for electronic filing with the Commission is Cascade's Amended Petition for an Order Authorizing Deferral of Costs and Benefits Associated with COVID-19 Public Health Emergency. The purpose of this amendment is to seek recovery on the raised COVID-19 bill assistance funding threshold by an additional 0.5 percent of retail revenues to an overall 1.5 percent funding level.

On October 28, 2021, in Docket UG-210801, Schedule 304 (Temporary COVID-19 Residential Bill Assistance Program) was approved to raise the threshold to 1.5 percent to help residential customers who are experiencing financial hardship due to the pandemeic.
