8 **Q. Please state your name and business address.**

9 A. My name is Jon A. Piliaris. My business address is 355 110th Ave. NE, Bellevue  
10 WA 98004.

11 **Q. By whom are you employed and in what capacity?**

12 A. I am employed by Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”) as Director, Regulatory Affairs. I  
13 have been employed by PSE since December 2008 and have been in my current  
14 position since April 2018.

15 **Q. What are your duties as Director, Regulatory Affairs?**

16 A. I am responsible for federal, state and regional regulatory policy; cost of service  
17 and pricing; tariffs; and overall regulatory affairs.

18 **Q. Briefly describe your education and experience prior to your employment at**  
19 **PSE.**

20 A. I hold a Bachelor of Arts degree in Economics from Pacific Lutheran University  
21 and a Master of Arts degree in Economics from the University of Colorado,  
22 Boulder. I have over 20 years of utility experience, primarily as a management

1 consultant for publicly-owned utilities that provide electric, natural gas, water  
2 and/or wastewater services.

3 From January 1995 to March 2006, I was employed by Economic & Engineering  
4 Service, Inc., later known as EES Consulting, Inc., a nationally recognized  
5 engineering and management consulting firm. I provided consulting services on  
6 behalf of EES Consulting in a wide variety of areas, including

- 7 • revenue requirements, cost of service, rate design, and  
8 related analyses,
- 9 • regulatory, litigation and arbitration support,
- 10 • representation within regional forums, such as proceedings  
11 at the Bonneville Power Administration (“BPA”),
- 12 • electric utility resource planning, evaluation and  
13 acquisition,
- 14 • utility property valuation and acquisition,
- 15 • new utility formation,
- 16 • financial forecasting and feasibility analysis, and
- 17 • management reviews and performance benchmarking.

18 After leaving EES Consulting in March 2006 as its Managing Director of  
19 Economic Analysis, I formed Economic & Financial Strategies, LLC (“EFS”).

20 From 2006 through 2008, I provided consulting services similar to those I  
21 provided on behalf of EES Consulting, with an emphasis in the areas of retail  
22 electric ratemaking, electric resource planning and financial modeling.

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I have testified in numerous rate proceedings before this Commission, the British Columbia Utilities Commission and BPA in the areas of cost of service, ratemaking and related analyses.
