
1. Pursuant to WAC 480-07-380 and the request of the Administrative Law Judge, Comcast Phone of Washington, LLC (“Comcast”) hereby requests permission to withdraw its petition for leave to intervene (“Petition”) in the above-entitled docket.
2. Comcast filed its Petition on or about May 27, 2010, in response to the Commission’s prehearing conference notice. Due to the shortened time provided for interested persons to seek intervention, Comcast filed its Petition to preserve its rights to participate in this docket while it continued to review the filings made by the applicants. Comcast ultimately decided not to participate and notified the parties at the prehearing conference that it no longer sought to intervene.
3. At the prehearing conference, Judge Friedlander did not rule on the Petition but orally granted Comcast’s request to withdraw it subject to Comcast making an appropriate filing with the Commission. She subsequently informed counsel that Comcast should file a motion to withdraw the Petition.

WHEREFORE, Comcast respectfully requests leave to withdraw its petition to intervene.
