1. They have shown the Rate Change of 4.41% (which seems excessive) without some amplification on Capital Investments and Operating/Maintaining.

Why not tell us what their 10 largest NEEDED Capital Investments are?

- 2. By not mentioning Service Charge, although shown, they are trying to pass a <u>50% Service Charge Increase</u> in addition to the Rate Increase, so the average residential customer won't be paying \$2.09 more per month but <u>\$4.09 more</u>.
- 3. Operating/Maintaining-Who is paying for the "FREE" fiberglass <u>Pipeline Marker post</u> near our mailbox and new <u>protective solid post</u> near my gas meter, both of which have been installed in last year?
