Qwest Corporation (Qwest) sent via electronic mail today to the parties and the Commission today a courtesy copy of a Motion for Modification of Order No. 08; Request for Expedited Resolution. Qwest plans to file a paper copy of the motion with the Commission tomorrow. In its motion, Qwest seeks to modify Order No. 08 to allow up to six (6) in-house experts to review highly confidential data. Order No. 08 establishes a limit of five (5) in-house experts with access to such information.
