NOTICE SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

TO ALL PARTIES:

On March 19, 2009, the parties in this docket advised the presiding officer that they had reached a settlement. On March 24, 2009, the parties filed a letter with the Washington Utilities and Transportation (Commission) stating that they are in the process of drafting their agreement for filing with the Commission. They anticipate filing their settlement by March 27, 2009, but will advise the Commission if additional time becomes necessary. In the meantime, they ask that the current procedural schedule be suspended.

The current procedural schedule calls for response testimony to be filed on March 27, 2009. Given that the parties expect to file their settlement agreement by that date there is good cause to suspend the schedule as requested.
