Summit View Water Work's Customer Notice of Public Comment Hearing

Dear Executive Director Killip:

On December 12, 2024, Summit View Water Works (Summit View Water or Company) submitted customer notices for review by Commission staff (Staff), to support any public comment hearing required by the Commission. Summit View Water now submits a revised notice for its irrigation customers, properly showing the amounts at issue as "annual rates" rather than "monthly rates." The revised notice for irrigation customers is included with this filing for Staff's review.

Summit View Water provided customers required notices of its initial filing on August 1, 2024, and the Company advised customers of their ability to file comments directly with the Commission. The Commission also considered the Company's proposed rate increase at its regular, September 26, 2024 open meeting. Further hearings in this proceeding may only serve to increase costs to the Company and its customers. In the event that the Commission requires an additional opportunity for public comment, however, the Company again urges that such a hearing be scheduled as soon as possible.
