NOTICE OF JOINT WORKSHOP
(Set for June 16, 2020, at 9:30 a.m.)

RE: Relating to Clean Energy Implementation Plans and Compliance with the Clean Energy Transformation Act, Docket UE-191023

TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS:

On January 15, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) filed with the Code Reviser a Preproposal Statement of Inquiry (CR-101) to promulgate new rules to implement certain sections of the Clean Energy Transformation Act (CETA),¹ centered on the implementation of Chapter 19.405 RCW and revisions to Chapter 80.28 RCW. The Commission filed the CR-101 under Docket UE-191023.

On March 17, 2020, the Commission and the Washington Department of Commerce (Commerce) held a joint workshop to discuss the incremental cost of compliance with the CETA as provided in RCW 19.405.060(3).

On April 28, 2020, Commerce published discussion draft rules to implement the aspects of CETA for which Commerce is responsible. On May 19, 2020, Commerce requested specific written comments by June 8, 2020, on its draft incremental cost rule (WAC 194-40-230), which is among the rules included in the April 28 discussion draft.

On May 5, 2020, the Commission issued a Notice for Opportunity to File Written Comments on its first discussion draft rules by June 2, 2020. Draft WAC 480-100-675, which is included in this discussion draft, contains proposed language on the incremental cost of compliance.
