**Re:** Net Power Cost Recovery: To what degree did the company over-recover or under-recover its net power costs in Washington during the period from 2000 to 2006?

## Response to WUTC Data Request 89

The Company objects to this request as not reasonably calculated to lead to the discovery of admissible evidence and to the extent it requires information not maintained in the ordinary course of business or development of a special study. Without waiving these objections, the Company responds as follows:

The Company has not performed the requested analysis. In addition, please note that for the period 2000 through 2006, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission has stated that there was not an approved interjurisdictional allocation methodology in place in Washington. The West Control Area inter-jurisdictional allocation methodology (WCA) was approved as part of the 2006 general rate case, which became effective in 2007.

Since 2007, the Company has under-recovered its net power costs (NPC) in Washington in every year, by an average of nine percent. Please refer to Confidential Attachment WUTC 89 for more details.
