**Question 8 -** *“Please provide additional information related to the competitive marketplace in which the household goods moving industry operates (e.g., service areas that are served by multiple household goods moving companies.)”*

**Response** – The regulated HHG Moving Industry is highly competitive in Washington State. WAC 480-15-190 Service Territory, states Household goods permits authorize statewide operations unless:

(1) An applicant elects to limit the service territory to specific counties; or

(2) The commission, by order, limits an applicant's service territory.

Therefore, consumers in every town, city and county within Washington State have access to multiple regulated Intrastate
