Pursuant to paragraph 246 of Final Order No. 06, Docket Nos. UG-040640 et al., Puget Sound Energy ("PSE" or "the Company") provides hereby notification that additional restoration costs for qualifying storm events have been incurred. Back-to-back wind storms on December 11th and 13th, 2006 are expected to add additional costs to those accrued for qualifying events earlier this year. The December 13th windstorm was the largest to impact the Puget Sound region since prior to the Inauguration Day storm in 1993.

PSE anticipates restoration costs for these storm events will qualify as outlined in the above referenced proceeding.
