Puget Sound Energy, Inc. ("PSE" or "the Company") advises hereby, as a courtesy notice, that restoration costs for the first qualifying storm events in 2007 have been incurred. A pair of back-to-back storms on January 5th and 9th, 2007, has resulted in the first qualifying event costs to be accrued toward the threshold for 2007. At this time, however, PSE's qualifying event costs still remain well below the threshold for deferral treatment and this advisory is being provided for informational purposes only.

The Company will later be submitting informational Qualifying Storm Event Reports, since these storms count towards the threshold, in accordance with Paragraph No. 246 of Final Order No. 06, Docket Nos. UG-040640 et al.
